**1. Discuss Fire-EMS Study**

City Clerk Administrator Monahan-Junek and Haas reported on 2 meetings they had attended at IRRRB with surrounding communities to discuss a fire-EMS study. The IRRRB has indicated their intent to fund such a study if the study included all the Quad Cities+ communities. The State Fire Marshall's office also offers grants to conduct studies; their funds will be available in FY18.

The consensus of the City Council is that Eveleth proceed with Fayal Township and Gilbert in exploring Fire-EMS consolidation. Monahan-Junek will set up the meetings with a facilitator.

**2. 2017 proposed budget & levy**

Monahan-Junek handed out a revised budget.

**3. Discuss proposed utility rate increases**

Director Rosati had previously distributed various rate scenarios he had developed and discussed with the Councilor Lillis and Mayor Vlasisavljevich (Public Utilities liaisons) and City Clerk Administrator Monahan-Junek.

The consensus is to move forward with implementing Proposal 1–Water and Proposal 3–Sewer.
