1. Storm Water Utility

Director Wiskow reviewed the hand-out provided in the City Council packet. The goal is to have the storm water utility in place by July 1, 2010 and billed on the July 30, 2010 utility billing statement.

2. EHSP Update

City Clerk-Administrator Monahan-Junek informed the Council of the Senate (Senator Berglin) bill currently being considered which included a provision whereby the State would continue the lease payments to the City for Mental Health through the lease term (11/30/2011), and the bill that would allow the nursing home to bill and receive additional Medicare reimbursement with a match from the City. Paul Fischer, Nursing Home Administrator, informed Monahan-Junek that he calculates that at full occupancy, the match required from the City would be \$9,000; Fischer suggested to Monahan-Junek that the City could pay the nursing home \$9,000 a month and the nursing home would pay the City back the difference between \$9,000 and the lease revenue received from the State for Mental Health.

The Council asked Monahan-Junek to invite Paul Fischer to the next City Council meeting to give a financial update on the nursing home.

3. Agenda Q&A

Councilor Kuoppala, on behalf of the Personnel Committee, suggested that the Accounting Clerk position be posted as part-time, 6 hours a day (.75).
