1. Update on Iron Range Resources Mineland Reclamation Community Grant Program

Director Wiskow gave an update on the Iron Range Resources Mineland Reclamation Community Grant Program. Wiskow suggested the City apply for 100 percent of the costs associated with filling in the sunken mine shaft near Cleveland Street and Adams Avenue.

2. Discuss Draft Stipulation Agreement received from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency dated January 22, 2010

A draft Stipulation Agreement from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency pertaining to alleged violations at the Eveleth Wastewater Treatment Facility was distributed to the Council in their agenda packets.

3. Leonidas Fire Protection Agreement & Park Lease

A report (prepared by City Clerk/Administrator Monahan-Junek) of expenses related to the operation of the Fire Department was distributed to the Council. The Leonidas City Council had requested a “fully burdened” report of expenses related to running the Eveleth Fire Department. The Council requested that a copy of the report be sent to the Leonidas Council.

Discussion took place on the Leonidas Park Lease. Councilor Kuoppala said she did not feel comfortable with paying for both park equipment and back pay of \$300.00 per year (for the years 2007, 2008 and 2009).

Both the Fire Protection Agreement and Park Lease will be placed on the next City Council Meeting.
