1. Discuss meeting held with Minnesota Pollution Control Agency with regard to their January 13, 2011 letter and August 18, 2010 Stipulation Agreement

Councilor Koivunen and Director of Public Works Mike Wiskow reported on their meeting with MPCA on February 18, 2011.

2. Discuss Board and Commission Application Process

The Council agreed to remove language on the Commission application which would require criminal and credit checks to be done on members with fiduciary responsibilities.

The current Joint Recreation Board agreement limits service for members to two consecutive terms. The Council has agreed to look into increasing the City of Eveleth's term limits to three consecutive terms. City Clerk/Administrator Monahan-Junek will research expanding the term limit for Eveleth.
