- Flames cannot go higher than 36";
- Fires must be at least 10' from structures, trees and/or flammable materials; and
- Know if there are fire restrictions or a fire ban in place.

Police Matters

NOTE: Calendar Parking Effective 24 Hours a Day!



The Police Department would like to stress to everyone that the calendar parking program, which remains in effect until May 1, **ALSO APPLIES DURING DAYTIME HOURS!** During this time of year the snow removal schedule is increased during daytime hours, and public works equipment need a clear path to safely and successfully provide these public services.

The Department will be actively enforcing this program and issuing citations; to comply, park on the **OPPOSITE** side of the street as the date (even/odd) **UP TO 6:00 p.m.**, when the change-over occurs.

Beware of Phone/IRS Scams and Protect Your Identity

This time of year sees an increase in the number and intensity of telephone scams, especially those relating to and/or claiming to be the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).

The Department would like to remind everybody that the IRS will not call you on the telephone and demand immediate payment of taxes, require you to pay a certain way (e.g. credit or prepaid debit card), or indicate that enforcement activity will be forthcoming if you fail to comply with those terms.

St. Louis County has revised the ANNUAL Solid Waste Service fees for Commercial properties, based upon the estimated market value (EMV) of a property. The 2016 rates are:

The City will accept trash and rubbish for disposal at the City Garage from April 18 to May 13, and will pick up yard waste in the City alleys on May 9, 2016.

DROP-OFF AT CITY GARAGE

The City will accept items for disposal at the City Garage, located at 6 Fayal Road, April 18 to May 13, 2016. Drop-Off hours are 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday-Friday. Extended hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday-Friday, will be offered from April 25-May 6, 2016.

This service is only available to Citizens of Eveleth; proof of residency will be required.

Items that may be brought to the City Garage include: Tires, batteries, appliances (white goods), scrap metals, building demolition, household goods (furniture, etc.), and household rubbish (clothes, kitchen items, etc.). **THE CITY WILL NOT ACCEPT TVs OR COMPUTER MONITORS FOR DISPOSAL. THESE ITEMS MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE ST. LOUIS COUNTY LANDFILL FOR DISPOSAL.**

Paint and like containers need to be empty and dry. **NO** hazardous waste, fluorescent tubes, containers with liquid, used oil, or empty petroleum-soiled containers will be accepted.

NOTICE: Yard waste (leaves, grass clippings, branches, etc.) will be accepted at the City Garage beginning April 18 and continuing until October 28, 2016.

YARD WASTE ALLEY PICKUP

The City will begin picking up **Yard Waste** in the alleys on **May 9, 2016**. Yard Waste must be placed in the alley prior to this date or it will not be picked up. Pickup will begin on the east side of the City (Station 44, Eastview, & Morningside) and proceed westerly. **There will be no second chance.**

PLEASE DO NOT pile yard waste next to the dumpster. DO NOT put yard waste in the dumpster. Excessive amounts of yard waste will be reviewed and the owner notified of a pending charge before they are picked up.

Anyone placing yard waste in alleys after the pickup is completed in that area could be cited for blight.

The City will **not** pick up Appliances, Tires, Batteries, Scrap Metals, Building Demolition, and/or Household Goods as a part of the citywide alley pickup. Anyone wishing to dispose of these items may either bring them to the City Garage during the times and dates listed above, or contact the Public Works Department at **744-7504** to request a special pickup. The cost for special pickups is as follows (Fees may be waived for persons with limited income): \$25.00 per dump truck load (customer loads); up to \$25.00 per pickup truck load (City loads), determined on an individual basis, based upon volume; \$10 per major appliance (City loads).
