

EVELETH VETERANS PARK

CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES

- ❖ No person shall camp in a tent or park a trailer in the campsite for overnight purposes without first having obtained a permit. No person shall place a registration receipt on the campsite identification post in advance of their arrival.
- ❖ Camping is allowed only in the designated campsites with only one camping unit per site.
- ❖ No group or organization of 6 or more persons shall use any of the campsites without written permission from the city.
- ❖ Maintain the campsites, picnic grounds and recreational area in a clean, orderly and sanitary condition at all times. Deposit all garbage, refuse and debris in the containers provided for you by the city.
- ❖ It shall be unlawful to remove any object or property from any area, or to destroy, mutilate or deface any property within the park, or to cut any tree or peel the bark off any tree in the area, or to make any excavations without the consent of the city.
- ❖ No animals, except household pets shall be permitted in the park, and dogs, cats, or other pets shall not at any time be permitted to run loose.
- ❖ No fires of any kind shall be permitted in any area except in the grills provided for in the camping and picnic areas.
- ❖ No firearms shall be discharged within the park, and all firearms shall be in legal closed containers.
- ❖ All automobiles, trailers and vehicles shall be parked only in designated parking areas. Speed limit signs are posted and enforced.
- ❖ No person shall create a disturbance, engage in brawling or fighting, disturb any meeting or persons using the premises, engage in offensive, obscene or abusive language, or conduct himself in a boisterous or noisy manner tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger or resentment in others.
- ❖ No person may fish from the swimming beach area or dock.
