A. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Vlasisavljevich called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

B. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Accepting Proposal for City Auditorium Architectural Services

Director Wiskow solicited proposals for City Auditorium Architectural services.
Proposals were received from Architectural Resources, Inc., DSGW, Roger Saccoman
Architecture, and Stantec Consulting/Benchmark Engineering.

from Stantec Consulting/Benchmark Engineering for City Auditorium architectural

2. Consider Proposal for City Hall Council Chambers Air Conditioning

Monahan-Junek stated that she wants to work with Architectural Resources to further
define the scope of work in the proposal and will bring this back to the Council at a later
date.

3. Consider Accepting Proposal for Library Gazebo Foundation & Sidewalks

library gazebo and accept the proposal from 3D Concrete & Construction for library
gazebo foundation and sidewalks. Ayes – All.*

4. Consider Approving Fall 2013 Refuse Collection and Yard Waste Pickup

*Motion by Councilor Lillis, second by Councilor Koivunen to approve the Fall 2013
Refuse Collection and Yard Waste Pickup schedule. Ayes – All.*

5. Consider Approving Amendment to Service Agreement with St. Louis County Environmental Services Department for Collection of Residential and Commercial Recyclable Materials

Motion by Councilor Koivunen, second by Councilor Hadrava to approve the Amendment to Service Agreement with St. Louis County Environmental Services Department for Collection of Residential and Commercial Recyclable Materials. Ayes – All.

6. Decision on use of 2013 legislated Taconite

The 2013 Legislative Session included a \$498,000 allocation to the City of Eveleth. Council previously advised staff to allocate \$250,000 to the auditorium renovation project and the remainder to 2013 Jones Street project. The Council does not intend to change this allocation.
