Reservation Policy

- **Use of the Eveleth Lake Park Pavilion and Dining Room Facilities are handled on a first come, first serve basis.** Rental times are from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. All parties must leave the facilities by 9:00 p.m.
- Reservations will be accepted by telephone or email; however an application shall be submitted within one week of making the reservation. **If the written application is not received, the reservation will be voided.**
- **Application forms may be obtained from the City Clerk's office during normal office hours.** The applicant may also request an application be sent by mail.
- **Applicants are responsible for the facility.** In order to receive the "residential" rental rate, the applicant must be a current resident of Eveleth. The applicant must remain on the premises for the duration of the event. Leaving the park will terminate the permit.
- **A damage deposit fee of \$50.00 along with the rental fee are due at the time of the application. Cancellations must be made in writing 30 days in advance or the damage deposit fee will be forfeited.**
- **The \$50.00 damage deposit will be held by the City and returned upon satisfactory inspection of the premises.** The City reserves the right to file a claim for damages beyond the deposit amount.
- **If alcoholic beverages will be consumed during the event, Applicants must apply for a Permit for Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages.** Permits must be authorized by the City or campground managers. The Applicant is responsible for the group's compliance with the terms of the permit. Glass beverage containers are not allowed.

- Picnic tables are not provided in the Pavilion. Groups must furnish their own tables and seating.

Park Guidelines

Welcome to Veterans Park. In order to make your event more enjoyable, please observe the following:

1. **Please register with the Manager upon your arrival.** The Manager will verify your permit and accommodate your group in the best manner possible. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask.
2. Both buildings are maintained in good condition, ready for group use. You are welcome and encouraged to visit the park in advance to discuss your plans with the Manager. When your event is concluded, please leave the buildings as neat and clean as you found them.
3. **For safety reasons, no glass beverage containers are allowed in the park.** Please notify all members of your group in advance that glass beverage containers are not allowed.
4. **Pets are the responsibility of their owners, and must be leashed and under the Owner's control at all times.** *Please pick up after your pet!*
5. **Deposit all garbage, refuse, and debris in the trash containers provided.** *Help keep the park clean!*
6. **Fires are limited to fire rings and fireplaces.** Fire rings and fireplaces are not to be used as trash receptacles. Please dispose of trash in the refuse dumpsters.
7. **No exposed firearms allowed in the park.** If you have one, keep it in a legal closed and secure container.
8. **For the safety of swimmers, NO fishing in the swimming beach area or from the docks is allowed at any time.**
9. **Observe all signs in the park, especially the 10-mile per hour speed limit.** Many people walk along the roadways and children playing often do not watch for approaching vehicles. Please drive carefully and be observant.
10. Operation of ATV's in the park will be solely for the purpose of entering and exiting the park on the road. Please stay off the grass and walking trails. **DIRT bikes are NOT allowed in Veterans Park at any time!**
11. This is a multi-use park and other family groups will likely be using the park at the same time your group is there. **Disorderly conduct ruins the outdoor experience for others and will NOT be tolerated!** Disorderly conduct is defined as any action that causes a disruption in other park activities and/or a disturbance to other groups, including campers. This includes the use of fireworks. The use of all types of fireworks on public property is illegal in the State of Minnesota. Violators will be reported to law enforcement, possibly resulting in immediate eviction. **(NO REFUNDS)**
12. **It is illegal to remove any object or property from the park, or to destroy, mutilate or deface any property within the park, or to cut any tree or peel the bark off any tree.** Violators will be reported to law enforcement, resulting in immediate eviction and suspension of future use of the park. **(NO REFUNDS)**
13. The City of Eveleth is not responsible for storm damage, accidents, theft or negligence of the other park users.
