1. Tour AEOA Rehabilitation Home at 206 Monroe Street

The tour was rescheduled due to time constraints.

2. Discuss Veterans Park Improvements

Barb Coz and Kathy Murphy from the Parks Commission asked the Council to consider the proposed improvements to the Veterans Park.

Monahan-Junek said that once the City's audit is finished they will have a better idea on how to fund the various improvements.

3. Discuss financing Veterans Park, Hippodrome, and Auditorium Improvements

Mayor Vlaisavljevich said there is a good possibility the City could get some funding from the IRRB to work on a handicap entrance and handicap accessible bathrooms.

Councilor Hadrava said the heating may work temporarily, but would probably need some new radiators and piping.

The fire sprinkling system also needs repair.

4. Agenda Q&A

Councilor Peterson discussed blocking off additional streets for sidewalk sales during Eveleth PUCK Days.

Chief Lillis distributed a copy of a letter from the U.S. Department of Justice regarding the 2012 COPS Hiring Program Funding. The grant will be awarded with more restrictions to include hiring of a military veteran. The Council agreed not to reapply as the City has made other unsuccessful applications in years past.
