**1. Review tabulation of quotations received for Veterans Park Underground Power**

Director of Public Works distributed a tabulation from the bid opening. Wiskow recommended accepting the quotation from low bidder Nelson-Collie Electric contingent upon submittal of the Certificate of Insurance and Project Labor Agreement.

**2. Smithsonian Exhibition – Filming in Eveleth**

Tiffany Ruhl, Smithsonian Institution Exhibition, has been in contact with Director Wiskow. On May 3<sup>rd</sup>, the Smithsonian Institution Traveling Exhibition Service will be filming inside the Hippodrome and interviewing local athletes both past and present, and local residents about what hockey means to them. They would also like to film landmarks around town including the Hockey Hall of Fame and the Big Stick. It was suggested the Mayor and available Council Members meet at the Big Stick at 2:00 p.m. to be interviewed. Anyone who is interviewed will need to sign a release.

**4. Discuss tax-forfeited property located on St. Mary's Lake**

Councilor Hadrava discussed tax-forfeited property located on St. Mary's Lake. Hadrava would like to see the City bring high end housing into the community. He would like the City Engineer to look at the property and determine whether lake shore homes would be feasible. Councilor Peterson would like to see a market study of the area. Director Wiskow will work with Eric Fallstrom, Benchmark Engineering, to look at the site.
