The Workshop Meeting began at 2:33 p.m.

**1. Lincoln Place patio and sidewalk**

Councilor Lillis said the parking lot at Lincoln Place is in need of repair. The estimated cost to fix the parking lot ranges from \$100,000 to \$120,000. Lillis said it is very disappointing that the work was not done properly.

City Clerk Administrator Monahan-Junek said the residents at Lincoln Place are requesting a patio with a sidewalk to the building. Great Lakes Management received quotes at approximately \$5,000. They do not have money budgeted for this item; however, the City would be able fund the project.

The Council agreed that Monahan-Junek will continue to move forward with the patio.

**2. Storage building**

The Public Works Department is in need of additional storage. Mayor Vlasisavljevich suggested the City purchase a predesigned building from Menards and have someone assemble it near the City Garage.

**3. City Policies**

Monahan-Junek distributed a proposed policy for tobacco free City vehicles. If approved, the policy would prohibit tobacco products in all City owned vehicles and equipment.

She also distributed the current policy which prohibits firearms. The Council discussed language which prohibits workers to have a firearm in their vehicle on City property. The general consensus was to change the language to allow employees to carry or store a firearm in their vehicle. However, the employee would have to keep the vehicle locked at all times to properly secure the firearm.

#### **4. Highway 53 proposed trail alignments Eveleth to Virginia**

Monahan-Junek distributed a map for the proposed trail alignments. She will ask Bob Manzoline to attend a Council Meeting to further explain the plans.
