1. Running water advisory follow-up

Discussion took place on residents and business owners who do not read their meters. Director Wiskow said the increased penalty rate from \$3.00 to \$10.00 per month (for not submitting a meter read) has not made difference in motivating noncompliant customers.

Director Wiskow also explained that there is a policy for residents physically unable to read their meters. Those residents can request an automatic meter be installed.

2. Letter from City of Gilbert regarding Quad City Food Shelf

The Quad City Food Shelf currently resides in the City of Gilbert. The building is in need of substantial repair. The City of Gilbert is looking for another venue to host the food shelf. Councilor Hadrava suggested the Eveleth Senior Center building. Councilor Peterson mentioned that the fiscal sponsor of the food shelf is AEOA.
