1. Discuss City's Proposal to Host Hockey Day

Councilor Hadrava distributed a proposal for Hockey Day to the Council. Hadrava said the proposal came from the steering committee of last year's Hockey Day, Elk River.

City Clerk Administrator Monahan-Junek said she would like to see Elk River's budget amount to host Hockey Day. Elk River has not provided a copy of their budget. Hadrava said we will get that information, but the steering committee needs to be in place first. Monahan-Junek said the school board needs to be committed, and Youth Hockey is a very important component. Hadrava said he will try to get Elk River's book work.

After reviewing the proposal, Councilor Koivunen said it looks like Hockey Day is a school function with the City providing maintenance.

Mayor Vlasisavljevich said the school should initiate the process. Councilor Peterson and Lillis concurred that the school should call the meeting.

Councilor Hadrava will talk with Jeff Torrel, Eveleth-Gilbert High School Hockey, to set up a meeting.

Others to include on the steering committee were suggested: Youth Hockey, United States Hockey Hall of Fame Museum, Laurentian Chamber, City of Gilbert, City of Hoyt Lakes, Mary Somnas.

2. Update on Filling Assistant Water/Wastewater Operator Vacancy

The Council approved posting for the Assistant Water/Wastewater Operator Vacancy at the last meeting. The applications will be due December 30th. Councilors Koivunen and Lillis will serve on the hiring committee.

Monahan-Junek distributed information on Carter Circle for Council consideration. Some of the lots are very large and could possibly be subdivided. The area is zoned R2 for single or multiple family homes.

The meeting adjourned at 9:17 a.m.
