## NOTICE TO THE CITIZENS OF EVELETH

The City will accept trash and rubbish for disposal at the City Garage from May 5 to May 16, 2025 and will pick up yard waste in the City alleys starting on May 27, 2025.

### DROP-OFF AT CITY GARAGE

Items for disposal will be accepted at the City Garage, located at 6 Fayal Road, from May 5 to May 16, 2025. The hours for the drop off are 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday. This service is only available to citizens of Eveleth; proof of residency is required.

Items that may be brought to the City Garage include: Tires, batteries, appliances (white goods), scrap metals, building demolition, household goods (furniture, etc.), and household rubbish (clothes, kitchen items, etc.). Paint and like containers need to be empty and dry. NO hazardous waste, fluorescent tubes, containers with liquid, used oil, or empty petroleum-soiled containers will be accepted.

THE CITY WILL NOT ACCEPT MATTRESSES, TV'S OR COMPUTER MONITORS FOR DISPOSAL. THESE ITEMS MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE ST. LOUIS COUNTY LANDFILL FOR DISPOSAL.

### YARD WASTE ALLEY PICKUP

The City will begin picking up yard waste in the alleys on May 27, 2025. Yard waste must be placed in the alley prior to this date or it will not be picked up. Pickup will begin on the east side of the City (Station 44, Eastview, and Morningside) and proceed westerly. **There will be no second chance.**

PLEASE, DO NOT pile yard waste next to the dumpster. **DO NOT** put yard waste in the dumpster. Excessive amounts of yard waste will be reviewed and the owner notified of a pending charge before it is picked up. **Anyone placing yard waste in alleys after the pickup is completed in that area could be cited for blight.**

The City will **NOT** pick up appliances, tires, batteries, scrap metals, building demolition, and/or household goods as a part of the citywide alley pickup. Anyone wishing to dispose of these items may either bring them to the City Garage during the times and dates listed above, or contact the Public Works Department at 744-7504 to request a special pickup. The cost for special pickups is as follows:

- \$35.00 per dump truck load (customer loads).
- A pickup truck load cost will be determined by the City on an individual basis, depending on amount of rubbish to be picked up.
- \$20 per major appliance (City loads).

***NOTE:*** Yard waste (leaves, grass clippings, branches, etc.) will be accepted at the City Garage throughout the year.
