Eveleth Cemetery Rules & Guidelines

- 1) One headstone allowed per family lot (Headstone must be centered on lot).
- 2) No excavation of any type will be permitted in the cemetery except by City employees.
- 3) Owners of lots are prohibited from planting trees or shrubbery of a permanent nature at the cemetery per Eveleth City Minutes of May 5, 1944
- 4) No interment of a body may be made unless the remains are contained in a casket or vault container.
- 5) The City of Eveleth does not allow green burials at the Eveleth Cemetery.
- 6) Artificial flowers allowed in boxes only and placed on monument end.
- 7) The City will not be responsible for stolen or damaged statues, ornaments, lights, or decorations of any type.
- 8) Ornaments, lights, statues, and flowers must be placed on monument end and be removed by October 1st. The City will remove anything left after that date.
- 9) Animals are not allowed to be buried in the Eveleth cemetery
- 10) Dogs and other pets are not allowed in the cemetery.
- 11) All vehicles must remain on the roadway
- 12) No lot shall be used for any purpose other than the burial of human remains.
- 13) No temporary or permanent structures of any type will be allowed in the cemetery.
- 14) Lot owners shall not allow interments to be made in their lots for pay, nor shall any transfer or assignment of any lot be valid without the consent of the City.
- 15) The City will not perform burials on Sundays or legal holidays.
- 16) Planted flowers and containers must be placed on the monument end.

Saturday Burials

- Burials on Saturdays must be scheduled with the Deputy City Clerk no later than noon on the Thursday before the weekend burial.
- For full burials, the funeral home must make arrangements with the City prior to finalizing burial arrangements with the family.
- Full burials on Saturdays are to be complete at the Eveleth Cemetery by noon. The City reserves the right to change this time based on staff availability or multiple Saturday burials.
