1. Auditorium rental

City Clerk Administrator Monahan-Junek discussed the possibility of raising the rental rates for the City Auditorium. The current rates are \$300/resident; \$350/non-resident. Councilor Koivunen agreed with raising the rates and asked about the possibility of getting an ice machine and refrigerator for the bar. Monahan-Junek will report back to the Council with some suggested rates.

2. Legislative priorities

City Clerk Administrator Monahan-Junek distributed a newsletter from Dave Lislegard. In his letter, Lislegard discussed bills he has authored to include investing money into ATV trails to connect the Quad Cities.

Monahan-Junek also distributed an excerpt from the League of Minnesota Cities magazine and the minutes from the last RAMS meeting.

Monahan-Junek plans to discuss the City's priorities with Lislegard to include the City Auditorium, water tower renovation, and sports funding for the Hippodrome remodeling project.
