Mayor Vlasisavljevich called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

1. Spring/Alley Cleanup

Mayor Vlasisavljevich asked the Council what they would like to do regarding Spring Clean Up. The original date was postponed due to COVID-19. Public Works Director Rosati suggested the date be moved to mid-May in order to get the word out to Eveleth residents. The time frame will be concentrated to two weeks of extended hours from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

2. Park

The Council discussed the Eveleth Veterans Lake Park. Depending on the State's orders, the City may have to fine tune some rules in the beginning of the season such as closing the restroom/shower facilities.

City playgrounds will remain open at this time.

3. Golf Course

Public Works Director Rosati said the City is allowed to maintain the golf course under the Governor's Order.

4. City Wide Rummage Sale

The City Wide Rummage Sale scheduled for early May was cancelled due to COVID-19. It was suggested the City could hold the sale in August. Although private garage sales will not be prohibited this summer, the Council is not leaning towards the promotion or sponsoring of a City broad event this year.

Mayor Vlasisavljevich would like to continue discussions at a future workshop regarding his request from the IRRRB for funding to Eveleth small businesses from the Douglas J. Johnson Economic Trust Fund. The Council agreed and would like a simple process to help small businesses in Eveleth who have been greatly impacted by temporary closures due to the Coronavirus pandemic.
